We are passionate about Bryn Tanat and the wonderful environment in which we live and share with our guests and protect this with our Green policies and conservation work.

Environment policy

Since first coming to Bryn Tanat in 1967 the family has a long term commitment to good environmental practice. Our aim is to conserve and enhance the beauty and the bio-diversity of the wonderful gardens and grounds at Bryn Tanat and to keep working on improving day-to-day practices and policies towards sustainability and responsible stewardship of resources. And we hope to encourage and inspire visitors in terms of how we care for the environment.

Land management

We are proud to have planted over two thousand trees in the gardens and grounds at Bryn Tanat, more than half of which are now semi mature; also for recreating the lost gardens and encouraging wildlife in all its forms. Of particular delight is the profusion of birds and butterflies.

Recycling and purchasing

We recycle paper, tins, plastic and glass bottles, and tetrapaks

The Hall has its own well.

We re-use plastic bags and office paper and try to keep refuse to a minimum.

Stationery is kept to a minimum as we have a comprehensive web site. Kitchen roll etc is made from recycled paper as near as 100% as possible.

Use of energy

Appliances are "A" or "B" rated for energy efficiency.

There are thermostatic valves on radiators.

Sensors on outside lights and where not guests are inducted and asked to switch these off when not required.

We use low-energy light bulbs. Guests are asked and encouraged to switch off lights in rooms, particularly bedrooms, when not in use.

Water consumption is minimised with reduced pressure to taps.

Enjoying nature

Books, maps and guides are provided for bird watchers and walkers. Birds are encouraged with feeders.

Local food

A file is kept for guests with details of local restaurants, pubs shops and suppliers of food locally.

Delivery of vegetables and local produce boxes from the farm shop, Pen-isa'r-llan is encouraged.
