



## BRYN TANAT HALL

### **Guests Information**

Peter, Susan and the Martin family, extend a warm welcome to Bryn Tanat Hall.

While we like to show our host guests around the Hall on their arrival there are times when this is not always possible, for example if they arrive after their guests, so these notes are simply for assistance.

### **Bedrooms**

Bedroom 2 is above the snooker room.

Bedroom 7 is the en suite master bedroom.

### **Living room**

The television in this room will accept games consoles etc.

The fire guard is made from chainmail and very heavy. Please support the weight as the guard is drawn.

### **Dining room**

Tumblers and wine glasses are in the corner cupboards and champagne glasses are in the wall unit in the kitchen.

Please use place mats.

Please do not take hot dishes from the ovens straight to the dining tables.

### **Kitchen and Entrance hall**

All the kitchen doors and drawers are soft close.

Please use both handles when operating the corner drawers.

The sideboard by the front door has a push and release mechanism. In this drawer you will find tourist information and our guest information folder.

Please do not push down on the island extractor. It is operated by remote control.

The sockets are mounted in the work surfaces and are retractable. To bring them up for use, tip the lid and pull upwards. Please do not push them down below the surface of the worktop.

There is a full inventory of the china, glass and kitchen equipment in the guests folder located in the top drawer of the sideboard in the entrance hall and on our website in 'Guest Information' link from the main page.

A special request; to maintain the quality of the cutlery please do not use an abrasive cleaning pad when hand washing the cutlery.

There are easy clean liners for the oven trays and easy clean liners for the ovens. If you are using bottom heat please do not place the oven liner on the floor of the oven, rather place it on the lowest shelf. Please do not dispose of the liners as you will be charged for their replacement.

### ***Tesco***

We ask that in the event of a Tesco delivery that the boxes are returned with the driver. Please do not store goods outside the front door.

### **Snooker room**

Young children must be supervised in the snooker room. Replacement costs for the cloth on the snooker table are in excess of £1,000.

There is a fire door in the centre of the bay window.

### **Utility**

Torches, vacuum cleaner etc are located in the cupboard under the spiral staircase

The tumble dryer is condensing and the water container is to the top left of the machine. Simply pull it out, keeping it level and pour the water from the front left corner away in the sink. The filter is at the front inside the door.



## BRYN TANAT HALL

### **General information**

#### ***Heating***

Bryn Tanat is an old Hall without the insulation afforded to a modern house and even though it is centrally heated with two log burners and two open fires we advise guests who particularly feel the cold to pack accordingly.

#### ***Outside entertainment***

Bryn Tanat has a premises license and we kindly ask guests to finish music and outside entertainment at 11.30pm.

#### ***Fireworks***

If you wish to have a firework display, professional or otherwise, please consult us in advance of your stay and we will advise on information we require, where and within what hours this can be undertaken.

#### ***Ball games***

Bryn Tanat has a large number of vulnerable windows and for this reason ball games of any kind are not allowed on the terrace, the west lawn or in the courtyard. We are pleased for you to play on the riverside lawn or on the mown area designated for games.

The Hall has two croquet sets available on request.

#### ***Maintenance***

From time to time the Hall will sustain damage. To maintain our high standards this is rectified immediately when possible, however, there are occasions when items need to be replaced. On such rare occasions we explain this to our incoming guests and apologise for any disappointment this may cause.

Bryn Tanat has its own septic tank and cannot accept any foreign objects in the toilets.

#### ***Waste and re-cycling***

Powys Council operates a black bag waste collection. Please do not over fill the bags. When full please place them outside the front door and we will remove them to our skip. Please do not put them out at night as animals will scavenge.

We re-cycle cans, plastic, glass, paper and cardboard and will provide containers for this by the front door which we will empty as required.

If you prefer to re-cycle yourselves the nearest collection point is on Llansantffraid village car park, distance 1½ miles.

We are conscious of our environment and kindly ask guests to switch off lights when they are not required.

### ***Parking***

Please park facing the Hall and not across the courtyard. In the event of there not being enough space please drive through the courtyard and park behind the Hall.

### ***Fires and fire wood***

The fires are wood burning only. Please do not use coal or any other solid fuel. We will provide logs and assistance with the fires.

The first two tubs of logs are free of charge thereafter logs are for sale at £5.00 per tub on request.

For reasons, including health and safety, under no circumstances should guests help themselves from the log store.

Please do not attempt to clean the wood burners and fire grates out. The Hall's fires burn at their best on a bed of ash.

### ***Smoking***

The Hall has a strict no smoking policy throughout and provides an ashtray under the cover of the entrance archway. For the summer months we provide sand buckets for the terrace. Please do not smoke in the doorways.

### ***Mobile phones***

Mobile phones have excellent coverage on the Orange network. For all other networks you will have to walk to the end of the lime avenue, sorry.
