In 2006, after 21 years within the Beer business Stewart took a healthy change in direction and was appointed as CEO Muller UK and Ireland based in Market Drayton, after 4 very successful years at Muller Stewart decided to step down from executive roles and take up “semi-retirement” with a portfolio of Non-Executive Director roles.
